

How to Fix the Size of the GreekKeys Unicode(US) keyboard (Mac OS)

These steps will provide a larger keyboard menu icon that will size normally on a Retina display. The old icon looks too small. These steps apply only if you already have GreekKeys Unicode installed on your system.

1. Under the Finder's Go menu, select Go to Folder... and enter

/Library/Keyboard Layouts

click on GO or press Return.

2. In the folder that opens, locate the file GKUall.bundle.

(If it is not there, go back to Step 1 and go to the alternative location: ~/Library/Keyboard Layouts.)

3. Right-click on GKUall.bundle and select from the contextual menu Show Package Contents.

4. Open the enclosed folder Contents folder, and then open the enclosed folder Resources.

5. Option-drag the file GreekKeys Unicode(US).icns into the Resources folder to copy it there.

6. Agree to replace the older file of the same name.

7. Do the same with the file GreekKeys Unicode(US_Alt).icns to replace the older version of that.

8. Log out and log back in, and the new larger icon will be is use in the keyboard menu.
